SUPERINTENDENT DIRECTIVE

SUBJECT: TITLE IV, PART A: SAFE AND DRUG-FREE SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITIES

AUTHORITY: *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, Title IV, Part A, as amended*

APPLICABILITY: Windham School District (WSD)

POLICY:

Under a Title IV, Part A grant from the Texas Education Agency, WSD shall support programs that foster a safe and drug-free learning environment that supports student achievement.

PROCEDURES:

I. Purpose

- A. WSD shall use Title IV, Part A funds to supplement drug and alcohol abuse and prevention education and violence prevention programs.
- B. WSD shall use Title IV, Part A funds primarily to support the WSD Cognitive Intervention and CHANGES (pre-release) programs.

II. Administration

- A. The Division of Instruction shall coordinate all Title IV, Part A grant activities, administer the budget, and processes all requisitions and vouchers associated with activities funded through the grant.
- B. WSD shall use an advisory committee in accordance with requirements of the grant.

III. Evaluation

Evaluation of the Title IV, Part A program shall be reported annually in accordance with the procedures specified by the Texas Education Agency.
